Our lessons follow the guidelines of the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages* (CEFR). This system helps to describe learners' foreign language achievements across the world. The CEFR divides learners into three broad divisions (A, B, C), which can be subdivided into six levels (A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2).



DESCRIPTION OF THE DIFFERENT LANGUAGE LEVELS



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A1

BEGINNER

You will learn how to form fundamental grammatical and communicative structures in the target language, such as greetings, talking about yourself, giving an opinion, conjugating verbs in the present tense, describing yourself and others and talking about likes and dislikes, among other skills. You will have a general basic ability to communicate in everyday situations. You will be able to convey simple messages in social and travel contexts.

A2

ELEMENTARY

In this level you will increase your level of grammar and vocabulary and be able to express yourself functionally in various communicative contexts in the present, future and past tenses. You will be able to communicate in short conversations on familiar topics and understand short simple text.

B1

INTERMEDIATE

In B1 you will acquire a general command of some of the more complex structures in the language and a good vocabulary base. You will make the leap from expressing yourself at a functional level to achieving a certain level of fluency in the language, accompanied by a greater comprehension of the country's way of life.

You will be able to sustain a conversation on familiar topics and will be able to produce and understand simple text with ease.

B2

UPPER
INTERMEDIATE

In this level, You will learn to feel comfortable communicating in social situations and speak with a certain degree of fluency. You will largely expand upon your ability to debate and express opinions in detail; to link phrases and sentences cohesively, and to converse about more specific topics outside the realm of commonplace linguistic interchanges. You will be able to communicate effectively in most language situations. You will be able to understand and produce text in general and in specialized areas of your life.

C1

ADVANCED

You will learn to express your ideas at a more abstract level by perfecting your grammar skills and dominating idioms, as well as gain a wider knowledge of the culture. You will be able to speak fluently to near-native speaker standard. You will have an in-depth knowledge and be able to use the correct register for formal/informal situations. At the end, you will have a solid grasp of the target language and are able to communicate effectively.

C2

PROFICIENCY

In this level, you will focus on refining your oral and written skills while developing a global perspective of the culture in relation to your particular field of interest. In C2 you will perfect all areas of linguistic proficiency in order to fully become bilingual.
